It will also help them with any sports, medical or performance needs to maintain their longevity in these activities, as well as allow them to participate in the sport of their choice by providing the equipment or gear they need that they may not be able to afford," say Dr. Bascharon.

Randa is elated that she is able to combine her love of athletics with her desire to assist the community. "It is important to remember to do unto others as you would want for yourself. We can share the blessings we have with others by reaching out in some capacity and helping those in need."

Also near and dear to Dr. Bascharon's heart is her involvement with several organizations that focus on breast cancer. "I do anything and everything I can for breast cancer. My mom is a survivor and I am thankful every day that she is, and try to show that by giving back to organizations that try to help others that suffer from cancer."
